- In General, Moral Philosophy Breaks Down Into Two Specific, Competing Moralities: Absolute And Relative
- Which Morality A Person Follows, Has Critical Implications For The Development And Quality Of Their Life
- Today's Society Is Increasingly Moving Towards Relative Morality, Away From Absolute Morality And Pushing God Out
- Relative Morality Leads To A Faithless Society & Cultural Decay
